## The Log House

---

The Log House was built in 1840 and stood for almost 50 years on what is now the corner of West Main Street and Walnut Street. In 1978, Mary Bozick, gave the house to the East Palestine Area Historical Society and it was moved to its current location. This property is now owned by the East Palestine City Park. It has been restored as closely as possible to its original appearance.

East Palestine Area Historical Society offers tours of the house. There are archivists that will correspond and help people with research. They also offer a few lectures throughout the year.
