Marriage Licenses and Records 1800-2009

Probate Records 1803-1970

COLLECTIONS

Mortgages Indexes 1850-1947:

Lists the name of the mortgagor, range and township, section, lot, amount of acreage, and amount paid

Mortgage Records 1850-1947:

Property owners who did not purchase their property outright

Deed Indexes 1795-1896:

Lists the name of the grantor and grantee, range and township, section, lot, amount of acreage and amount paid

Deeds 1795-1896:

Contains the names of the grantee and grantor who purchased and/or sold land and the location and description of the property purchased or sold

Marriage Records 1800-2009:

Listed alphabetically on index cards

Birth Records 1867-1908:

Listed alphabetically on index cards, these are not actual birth certificates.

Death Records 1867-1908:

Listed alphabetically on index cards

Probate Docket and Administration Docket 1837-1984:

Refers to an estate or will and the inventory record of the deceased.

Common Pleas Court Appearance Dockets 1850-1965:

Records indexed by plaintiff and defendant, will show case number, cause of action, disposition, journal entries, and a record book location.

Common Pleas Court Record Books 1808-1975:

Exact transcripts of each case

Naturalization Records 1808-1984:

Contain the declaration of intention, petition, and naturalization

Taxes 1819-1935:

Lists who owns property in each district/township of the county and the taxes paid. It also includes when and to whom property was sold.
